

TSA Privacy Act Notice

The Transportation Security Administration of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security requires Burgess Aircraft Management, LLC (dba Ozair Charter Service) to collect information from you for purposes of Watch List screening, under the authority of 49 U.S.C. section 114, and the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004. Providing this information is voluntary; however, if it is not provided, you may be subject to additional screening or denied transport or authorization to enter a sterile area. TSA may share information you provide with law enforcement or intelligence agencies or others under its published system of records notice. TSA Required Passenger Data

- Full Name (as it appears on gov't issued ID)
- Gender
- Known Traveler # (Pre-Check, Global Entry, etc.)
- Date of Birth (DOB)
- Redress Number (if applicable)
- Passport Info (if traveling international)

TSA Passenger ID Requirement

Each passenger who appears to be 18 years of age or older must present a valid form of identification as described in the following three options. An expired ID is not valid for the purposes of this check.

- 1) A photo ID issued by a government authority.
- 2) Two other forms of ID, at least one of which must be issued by a government authority.
- 3) Twelve-Five Aircraft Operator issued photo ID for direct employees of the issuing operator.

Hazardous Materials Policy Notice

Ozair Charter Service wants to help you avoid carrying anything onboard that violates U.S. Federal Law because violators are subject to imprisonment of up five years and penalties of \$250,000, or more. Some ordinary products can be dangerous when transported on aircraft because changes in temperature and pressure can cause leaks, toxic fumes, or fires. Please ensure such items are not in your baggage.

Burgess Aircraft Management, LLC (dba Ozair Charter Service) is a **WILL-NOT CARRY** Hazardous Materials air carrier and will not accept any form of Hazardous Material for transport unless it complies with the exceptions for passengers as listed in [49 CFR 175.10](http://49CFR175.10).
